APPLYING	Applicants must submit <u>all</u> selected admission program requirements listed below in order to be considered for review. Once an application packet is submitted, it cannot be amended.
INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS	Students who attempt to submit an incomplete application will not be processed and must reapply to the program and must pay the selected admission application fee once all requirements have been met.
DEADLINE	Complete applications are due NO LATER THAN 7:30 PM BY THE DEADLINE DATE OF July 24 for August admission and NO LATER THAN 7:30 PM BY THE DEADLINE DATE OF NOVEMBER 10 for January admission. If the application deadline date falls on a day the College is closed, the application will be accepted no later than 7:30 pm on the next day the College is open for business.
NO RESPONSE/ FAILURE TO ENROLL	Applicants who do not respond to an offer of admission by the date indicated on the acceptance letter or who fail to enroll for the term for which admission is offered must reapply for a future date.

SELECTED ADMISSION PROGRAM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1	PHSC "baccalaureate" general admission application (on-line) with a \$25 non-refundable fee for new students or a readmission application for prior PHSC students not enrolled for more than 3 consecutive terms. No fee for current or returning PHSC students.
2	Bachelor of Science in Nursing paper application AND signed checklist
3	Copy of receipt of payment of \$25 non-refundable selected admission application fee payable at college store.
4	Official high school transcript with graduation date indicating receipt of a standard high school diploma or official transcript of GED scores indicating receipt of a high school equivalency diploma, if not already submitted. Foreign Language: HS transcript must show completion of 2 years of instruction in one foreign language with passing grade to meet foreign language requirement. Foreign language requirement can be met (after admission to college) but prior to the completion of the bachelor's degree if not completed in HS program.
5	Official transcript from each U.S. College and university attended other than PHSC.
6	Admission GPA requirement: Cumulative GPA for college level credits of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
7	College level math: Student must meet the requirement for college level mathematics. MAT1033 or MAT1100 (completed with a grade of "C" or higher) or higher college level math course, or appropriate placement test score that verifies student is ready to take any area II college level math course
8	College level reading and writing: Student must meet the requirement for college level reading and writing. Ready to take ENC1101 English composition I or higher course
9	Earned AS Nursing or Nursing Diploma: Official transcript showing an Associate in Science Degree in Nursing from a regionally accredited institution or an earned nursing diploma from school accredited by the National League of Nursing Accrediting Commissions (NLNAC) or Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN). (Other than PHSC nursing graduates)
10	RN License: Copy of current, unrestricted, unencumbered registered nursing license from the state in which the applicant is practicing, to be kept current throughout the duration of the program.
11	Essay: "Philosophy of Nursing Education and Clinical Practice." Essay requirement and template are available at: https://phsc.edu/academics/degrees-and-programs/health-sciences/nursing-bachelor-science
12	Graduation: If selected, I understand that I must have both an overall GPA of 2.0 and a PHSC program GPA of 2.0 in order to graduate from the selected program.

SELECTION PROCESS: Applicants who meet minimum requirements as of the deadline dates will be selected based upon essay by committee.
